Why are we called U3A?

U3A is short for University of the Third Age. We are a university in the original sense of the word: a collective of people devoted to learning with members not students, enhancing your lifestyle with learning and social activities. all of whom are in their Third Age.

Group Leaders

Group Leaders are the backbone of U3As. There are no qualification requirements just a willingness and thirst to learn and share with others. You may wish for instance to learn a foreign language, meet to share photography tips, take up computing, or begin to play bridge; as a group, you can learn together. Maybe you would like to lead a cycling group, or organise an outing or trips?

Who can join U3A?

Anyone in the Third Age can join U3A and this includes people who are working part time. No qualifications are required, and none are given. There is no lower age limit for membership.

Together we can keep our minds and bodies active. There are hundreds of possibilities when you join a U3A. Whatever your interest we can together help form a group and start a new learning experience.

In Higham and Rushden U3A we have a Group Coordinator who can help set up a group when enough people are interested in a particular subject. The committee members are volunteers from among the membership and are elected on an annual basis.
